SURVEY RESULTS

- 100% of participants both nonprofits and pro bono volunteers would recommend Impact Day
- 84% of volunteers said this was an opportunity to apply their professional skills in a new context
- 78% of nonprofits said they gained new knowledge of pro bono and/or capacity building resources
- 45% of volunteers plan to continue working with the nonprofit beyond Impact Day

DELIVERABLES FROM IMPACT DAY INCLUDED...

Identifying Key Success Metrics:

- Developed volunteer leadership structure
- Developed responsibilities to improve efficiency and succession planning.

Document process mapping:

Guided strategic decisions based on current realities and challenges

Reviewing an Internal process:

- Streamlined the process by eliminating redundancies
- Outlined a quality assurance process.

Created a SWOT analysis:

- Drafted KPIs
- Created priorities for next steps
- Set up a framework to prioritize team work for the next several months

Defined short and long term goals:

- Created a housing budget for various phases
- Created a cash flow plan and fundraising ideas
- Built a PowerPoint presentation to use in fundraising pitches
